Due to National issues, the supplier had to stagger the provision of the Fluad vaccinations (recommended for the over 65s). We were therefore not able to give vaccinations to as many as usual on our planned Flu Day of the 29 September. On the 22 November we had another dedicated Flu day to vaccinate further patients. Over the two sessions, we vaccinated 1028 patients (compared with 862 patients in our 2017 Flu Day).

If you are eligible for a flu vaccination and have not yet had your jab, please speak to reception. The flu vaccination is also still available at many pharmacies.
